Thank for your interest in serving on the E3 Preparatory and Leadership Advisory Board. Listed below are the minimum criteria for incoming board members for the current term, which will be enforced, during the ensuing year and going forward.

Minimum Criteria for Prospective Advisory Board Members:

1. Have a passion for working with youth and young adults
2. Have expertise in one of the following areas: Education, HR, Business, Clergy, Legal, Marketing, Program Development, Fundraising, Grant Writing, Finance, Strategic Direction, Branding, Advertising, Strategic Direction, Corporate Sponsorships, Community School Partnerships, Technology, Non-Profit and Start-Up Organizations
3. Will attend at least 75% of board meetings on time and miss no more than 3 consecutive meetings which are unexcused
4. Will pledge and pay pledges on an annual basis
5. Will actively support fundraising, initiatives, and ventures of the organization and Board
6. Will notify the Board Chairperson when unable to fulfill duties as a board member, with effort made to give a 30 days notice.

Responsibilities of the Sponsoring Board Member:

1. Contact person to determine his/her interest level prior to submitting their name.
2. Submit the name(s) of persons to be considered for board membership.
3. Prepare a brief narrative of the nominee(s) strengths in consideration for board membership.
